Message From Your President

Dear Mr. Lorz and Members of the Jewett Family of America:



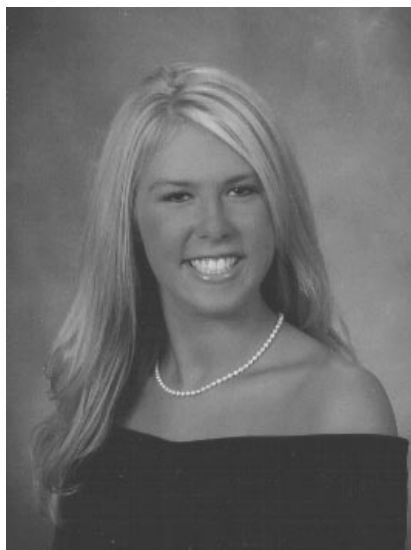

Excerpts from an address given by Robert H. Jewett at the service for his brother, March 2006.

Lincoln Hale Jewett was born December 31, 1908. He was the third oldest of four boys. Lincoln was called into World War II, serving in the Signal Corps and was shipped to England on the Queen Mary. While still at sea, the entire unit was transferred to the Infantry to take part in the African invasion. During a battle, Lincoln was separated from his unit. He found himself behind enemy lines and hid in a wadi while a German motorized column roared by, not many feet away. Alone and with little sustenance, he walked through the Atlas Mountains for a week until a boy found and took him to his father. From there he was able to return to American lines. He recovered from exhaustion in time to take part in the invasion of Sicily, followed by the Italian campaign. Following the War, Lincoln met and married Olive "Sunshine" King. They had a daughter, Michelle and two sons, Fred and Chris. They were blessed with three grandchildren, Bunky, Marielle and Kestrel. Lincoln indulged his love of classic boats, owning several including a sailboat, a cruiser and an 1897 sloop, "Jilt". Lincoln fought valiantly against severe illness that took away his strength and movement and lost the battle March 22, 2006.

**"The Jewett Family of America", Incorporated, Represented in Sioux Falls, Iowa
Ten Thousand People Trace Ancestry to One – Hold Convention Every Year**

"Sioux Falls is represented in one of the most unique corporations of today, known as "The Jewett Family of America". This fact became known a few days ago when George A; Jewett of Des Moines, Iowa, who was in the city on legal business, casually remarked to a close personal friend, C.L. Dotson, Publisher of "The Press", that he was recently honored by being elected President of the Corporation.

At first reticent, but soon animated by family pride, D.C. Jewett, of this city, when interviewed by a reporter for "The Press", unfolded an interesting tale of the Jewett Family – a story of interest to more than the Jewetts.

Incorporating a family is a modernized method of preserving to posterity the personnel of the "family tree". In medieval ages the family Bible flyleaves were used and the Bible was handed down as an heirloom.

So-called "family trees" are a source of pride in many families, a source of regret in some, considered a necessary evil in others, but nearly every person can trace his ancestry back some distance. Some trees – to preserve the simile – are mere bushes or, worse yet, only stumps, while others have branches extending in every direction and leaves on the branches.

The Jewett "family tree" is an immense plant with two large limbs branching from a main trunk and supporting something over 10,000 "leaves". It is a family tree in which composing units take great pride.

The Jewett family genealogy is bound in two volumes of about 1,000 pages each and traces the Jewett ancestry beyond the time of the Jewett advent in to America in 1638, when Joseph and Maxmillian Jewett, two sons of Edward Jewett of England, settled in Rowley, Mass. From these main limbs has sprung 10,000 Jewetts. Every Jewett points with pride to the family coat of arms granted many years ago in England when a Jewett was knighted.

Every two years a convention of the Jewetts is held at Rowley, Mass., at which time new officers are elected.

Edward Jewett was clothier in England when clothiers not only sold clothing but also manufactured it. History has it that the clothing industry in American began in Rowley, Mass. And it is claimed by the Jewetts that their ancestors began the industry.

D.C. Jewett of Sioux Falls is justly proud of his lineage. It is been identified with the upbuilding of America and played an important part in the revolutionary war.

Some time ago the son of F.B. Gault, former president of the South Dakota State University at Vermilion, made application for membership in the Sons of the American Revolution". He based his claim to that distinction on being an offspring of Elam Jewett, great grandfather of D.C. Jewett and an officer under General George Washington. Frank L. Blackman of this city inquired of Mr. Jewett if she could connect the younger Mr. Gault with the patriots of the revolution and Mr. Jewett traced the name to Elam Jewett, thereby establishing his eligibility to membership.

C.O. Bailey of this city has found in the Jewett "Family Tree" a distant relationship with his name and from it is gathering data for the Bailey family tree.

The historian of the Jewett family issues a supplement annually and after several of theses are issued another volume will be published.
